Our review of your medical records has established that you are eligible for a third-class medical certificate.

The certificate you now hold is valid until the normal date of expiration.

You are cautioned to abide by Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFRs), Section 61.53, relating to physical deficiency. Because of your history of refractive surgery (PRK), operation of aircraft is prohibited at any time new symptoms or adverse changes occur or any time medication and/or treatment is required.

You are cautioned that any further history of legal difficulties may require re-evaluation of your eligibility to hold an airman medical certificate.
